Synchrotron Radiation Facilities in the USA: Accelerator Status Report^{*}, G. DECKER, ANL -With the successful commissioning and achievement of significant milestones at both the 7 GeV Advanced Photon Source (APS) at Argonne National Laboratory and the 1.5 GeV Advanced Light Source (ALS) at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, synchrotron radiation research capability in the United States holds the promise for many important discoveries in the decade to come. An overview of current accelerator commissioning performance at the American thirdgeneration light sources, state-of-the-art developments at first- and second-generation sources, and a preview of fourth-generation source progress is presented.
