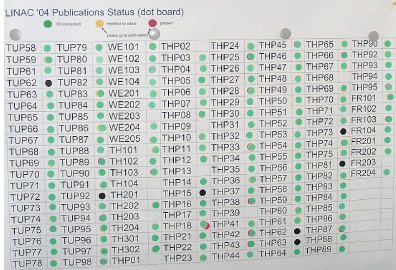
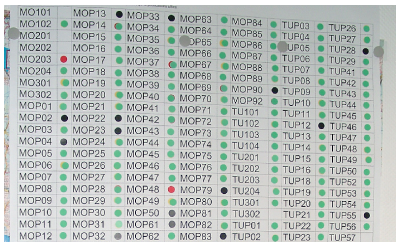

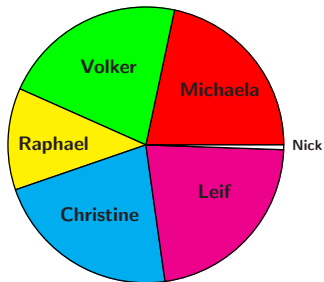


Why $4\frac{1}{2}$ permanent editors?

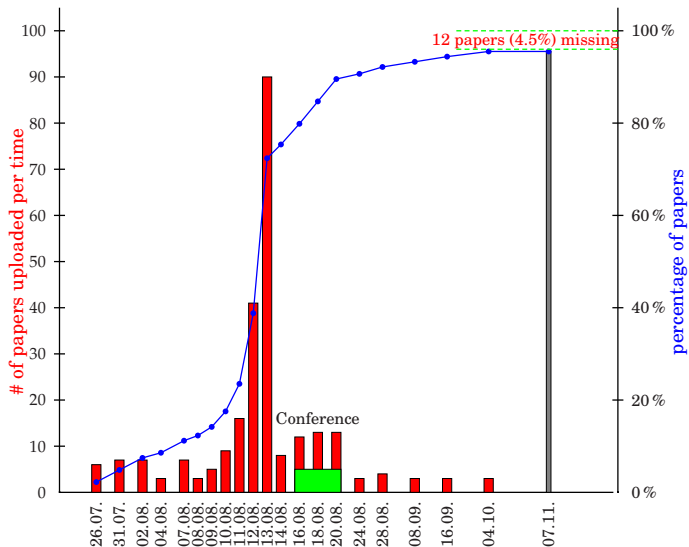
Status


- ▶ **Deadline for paper upload: two days before conference**
 - ▶ 75 % of papers before deadline
 - ▶ decision: upload stays open during conference
 - ▶ 90 % of papers till end of conference

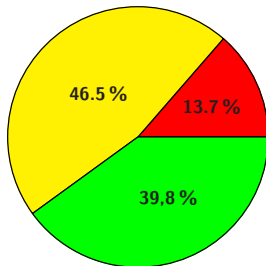
- ▶ Checking author and title info
- ▶ A check on 66 papers showed:
 - ▶ 23 are ok (no changes)
 - ▶ 19 papers with title changes
 - ▶ 48 additional authors, of which 35 are new
 - ▶ 3 authors have to be deleted
- ▶ If this scales, then with 268 papers
 - ▶ 93 will be ok
 - ▶ 77 papers with title changes
 - ▶ 194 additional authors, of which 142 are new
 - ▶ 12 authors have to be deleted
- ▶ Is this LINAC specific (newcomer to JACoW)?
- ▶ Christine, what's your opinion?

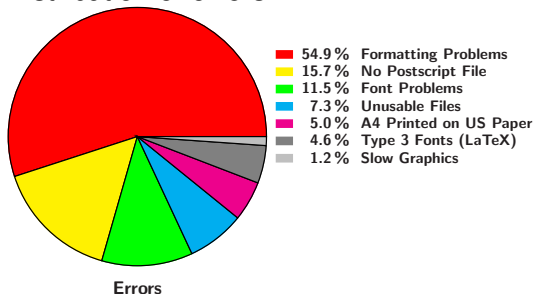
Initial Paper Status

- Authors: Same names (as always)
- SPMS:
 - Vanishing papers (online abstract withdrawals)
 - Upload errors (file locking by Acrobat)
 - Wrong tagged Mac files (most were Intel PC)
 - Wrong paper name (paper code) when uploading

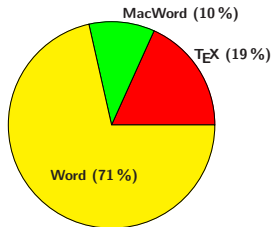
