Templates

- MS Word - two (A4 and US paper) each for the current and previous PC and Macintosh versions (eight total)
- LaTeX - one source (.tex) file and one style (.cls) file
- One Encapsulated PostScript (.eps) file containing the figure used in the template
- Text of template file contains instructions

Current practices (continued)

Manuscript preparation instructions

- Checklist for margins, column/gutter widths, fonts, text formatting
- Information on preparing electronic manuscripts
 - Overview of electronic processing
 - Tips on using MS Word and LaTeX
 - Preparing graphical images
 - Scanning images
 - Troubleshooting
 - Miscellaneous links to helpful software (e.g. Ghostview, Emacs)
- FAQ (PAC99)

Current practices (continued)

Submission instructions

- FTP files prior to conference
 - Preview PDF file
- Turn in the following at conference
 - Diskette/CD
 - Hard copy of paper
 - Signed copyright release form
 - Paper submission sheet
 - * Paper # and title
 - * Submitting author
 - * Number of pages
 - * Keywords (maximum of 5)
 - * Software and hardware used to create files
 - * Hardware used to create diskette/CD

Common Mistakes

- Wrong fonts used in text
 - LaTeX users -- Type 3 fonts
 - Word users -- Cyrillic/Asian or non-standard English fonts
- Not following formatting rules (e.g., point sizes, bolding, section numbering)
- Using ‘illegal’ fonts in imported figures, graphs
- Adjusting margins, line spacing to squeeze text into allotted number of pages
- Using graphics packages or file formats that are discouraged (e.g., .gif or .jpg files instead of .eps, creating .eps files with Illustrator or Photoshop)

What's Hard for Authors

- Difficulty using an unfamiliar word processor
- Templates can translate slightly different for various hardware/software configurations and can get corrupted
- Templates not always easy to modify (e.g., area for writing support statement at bottom of 1st column)
- Templates should be more tolerant of author's cutting and pasting
- EPS files not always created with preview can't see image in Word

LaTeX—

- Need to resolve missing Times font package problem
- Have to tweak documentclass and figure area; there are usually problems with LaTeX template

Recommendations

- Thoroughly test templates
- Add a full-width section (e.g., table, figure) to template
- Use a macro to set formatting defaults
- Keep the ftp server up longer
