The 9<sup>th</sup> edition of the Mechanical Engineering Design for Synchrotron Radiation Equipment & Instrumentation, *MEDSI*, was held in Barcelona (Spain) between September 11<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> hosted by ALBA Synchrotron Light Source.
